TERMS AND CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO THE NOTIFICATION
FOR PURCHASE OF BARYTES POWDER

1. E-tenders are invited for the supply of Barytes powder for the supply at Rubber Sheeting Factory at Kulathupuzha estate of the company.
2. Last date and time for uploading the tender in the e-tender site is 20.07.2018 at 5 pm . The tenders will be opened at 11am 24.07.2018. Every intending bidder has to sign the conditions on each page in token of having accepted the same and upload the same.
3. Rate quoted in column 54 of the BOQ should be inclusive of tax, transportation, loading & unloading charge. But Rate break up details should be uploaded in the given format.
4. All the intending bidders will have to furnish an Earnest Money Deposit of ₹ 5500/- through on line facility. Exemptions, if any, will be allowed as per government order on submission of required documents in that respect
5. The rate quoted should be for delivery at R.S Factory. Supply of the item is as per the requirement of the Manager, Factory Complex.
6. The Managing Director of the company reserves the right and power to accept or reject any tender without assigning any reason.
7. The earnest money deposit will be refunded automatically through electronic means within one week of finalization of the contract to all whose offers have not been accepted.
8. The Contract will be concluded on issue of Purchase order by the Company. The tenderer whose offer has been accepted will have to enter into a formal written agreement with the company for supply of Barytes powder as per the terms and conditions fixed by the company within 7 days of issue of the purchase order, failing which the EMD is liable to be forfeited and the purchase will be effected at the risk and cost of the Bidder whose offer has been accepted by the Company. Addresses for communications with Pin code and telephone number should be given by the intending Bidders.

9. The material supplied should conform to the following Specifications.
 - Particle size : 90% through 300 mesh
 - Purity : 92 – 96%
 - Sp. Gravity :4.3
 - Colour :White
10. The supplier should guarantee that the minimum required ingredients are included in the bulk supply of each item.
11. All the tenders should submit samples of the item within three days of the opening of the Tender.
12. The successful bidder should furnish security deposit @ 5% of the total purchase value for the due performance of the contract after having accepted the tender by the company and before executing agreement. EMD in respect of successful tenderer will be retained and adjusted as part of the security deposit.
13. Billing should be done as per GST requirements by the supplier and should be sent to the Manager, Factory Complex of the company. Payments will be made only after receiving Quality report and stock certificate from the Manager. All payments will be made by Account payee cheques/ NEFT.
14. The rate quoted should be firm till the company accepts the same. No representation for enhancement of rates once accepted will be considered on any account.
15. The supply of materials should be as per specifications and supply schedule in the annexure and as per purchase order issued by the Company. If the supplier fails to supply the articles within the time frame as per specifications, arrangements will be made to get the materials from other sources at the risk and cost of the supplier and the difference in cost including the advertisement charges and other expenses, if any, will have to be borne by the defaulted contractor and the same will be recovered through legal means/Revenue Recovery Proceedings/from any other amount due to the contractor from the Company. Even if, the difference in rate received in the alternate arrangement is less than the rate given by the original contractor, he will not be eligible for this difference in rate.
16. The Security deposit will be forfeited in case of any breach of contract, by the contractor. In case there is no liability, the security deposit will be released after the supply is completed and after getting the non-liability certificate from the respective Manager.
17. The Managing Director of the company has the right to terminate the contract by giving 15 days notice. The contract can be extended for a period up to two years on mutual agreement with the same terms and conditions.
18. Special conditions, if any, written on the tender or attached with the tender will not be applicable to the contract unless they are expressly accepted by the Company in writing.

19. The quantity of the articles specified in the present requirement is subject to variation according to the requirements at the time of Purchase.
20. The supplier must also enclose a test report of the material supplied at the time of delivery.
21. Material supplied should be environmentally safe and specific mention must be made if the product supplied contains any toxic/environmentally hazardous material. The material safety data sheet (MSDS) of product supplied must be enclosed wherever applicable and the Transporting vehicles should carry TREM CARD if required
22. The Bidder agrees that time wherever specified is the essence of the contract.
23. If the date of tender happens to be a holiday, the tender will be opened on the next working day.
24. Any dispute arising out of this contract, all suits or other legal proceedings in connection with any of the matter regarding the supply shall be instituted in the Courts at Punalur only.
